In partnership with Landmark Resource Management Ltd., Nicomen Indian Band has produced a survey to gather community knowledge and comments as it relates to the Trans Mountain Expansion Project (“TMX”) in Nicomen Indians Band’s traditional lands and greater Nlaka’pamux territory.

In the past, Landmark researchers have come to the community to interview members in person.
